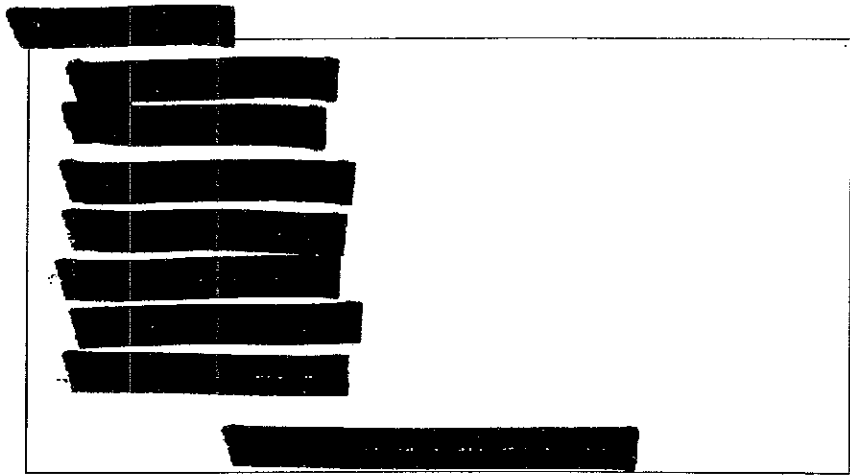

On November 28, 2005, [REDACTED] of the Maryland State Police's Homeland Security and Intelligence Division was contacted by Executive Protection Division troopers about a protest group which disrupted a visit by the Governor at an event.

According to [REDACTED] completed by [REDACTED] a group of approximately 12 protestors were at a function attended by Governor Ehrlich on November 17, 2005. The group protesting the Governor's visit to a Montgomery County high school was the Chesapeake Climate Action Network. One of the protestors "aggressively" tried to approach the Governor, others tried to get into the school and some of the protestors tried to recruit students to carry signs inside of the event, according to the report. The report was to document CCAN's aggressive protesting.
