
Executive Summary:

The Maryland Technology Development Corporation (TEDCO) is sponsoring a conference entitled Creating Superior Biomedical Technologies: Research and Commercial Opportunities on July 14, 2005 from 0800 - 1500, at the Holiday Inn FSK, 5400 Holiday Drive, Frederick, Maryland. The US Army Medical Research and Material Command in Ft Detrick is the Department of Defense's medical research, technology and material developer and is associated with this conference.





On June 5, 2005, there was a demonstration/rally at Baker Park in Frederick, Maryland which began at 1:30 pm.
