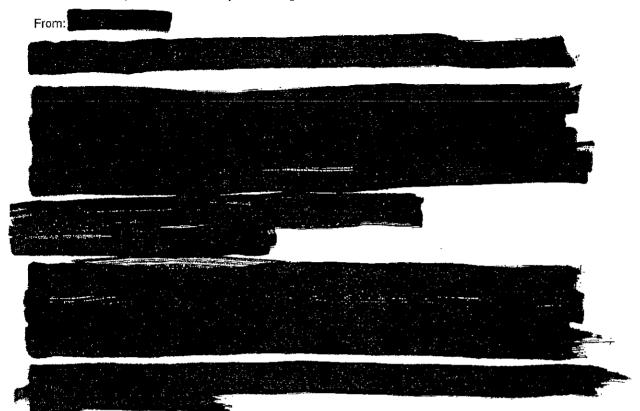
Baltimore Emergency Response Network (BERN):

BERN started protesting NSA's US military involvement (in particular the Military's potential use of space) in 1996. This appeared to have ended in 2001, following an NSA protest on October 12, 2001, when BERN members Ellen Barfield, No. 10.1 altempted to deliver a letter to Lt. General Michael V. Hayden, head of the National Security Agency, demanding a meeting. Leach demonstrator was arrested and charged with trespass [six months/\$2500 fine], destruction of government property [one year] and conspiracy [1 to 5 years]. The protesters were arraigned in U.S. District Court in Baltimore on March 22, 2002 but the government never scheduled a trial and the case appears to have been dismissed. Two of the arrestees were tentatively identified as:

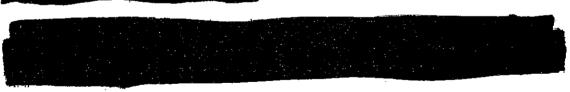

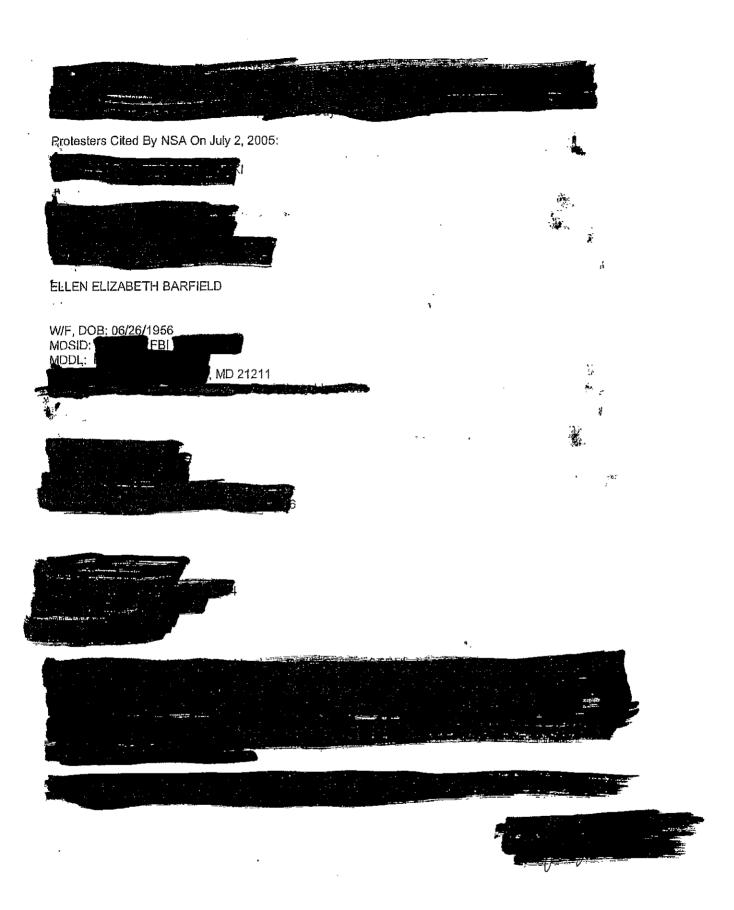
NSA Operational Intelligence:

Eight members of BERN protested at NSA on July 2, 2005. In general they were very orderly and even brought food and water for the military police. Comments by the protesters indicated that they could not cause trouble because some of them were on probation. When asked if they were also going to protest on July 4th they said no but that they could not speak for other groups. The leaders demanded to speak with someone in charge at NSA. This request was refused. At this time the demonstrators were asked to leave. Two refused and as a result were cited for protesting in an unauthorized area. They were identified as previous NSA BERN protesters and Ellen Barfield. Their citations are believed to have been lodged with Ft. Meade authorities.

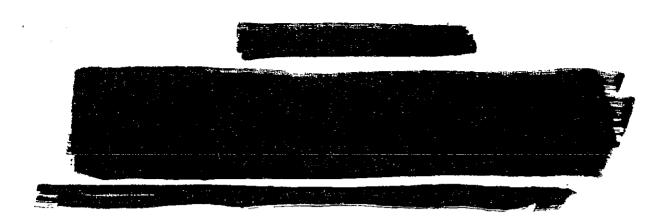
