**ORDER**

For the reasons stated in the accompanying Memorandum Opinion, it is ordered by the United States District Court for the District of Maryland that:

1. Plaintiffs-Petitioners’ Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction, ECF No. 2, is **WITHDRAWN** without prejudice;
2. Plaintiffs-Petitioners’ Motion for Preliminary Injunction, ECF No. 7, is **GRANTED**;
3. Defendants-Respondents’ Motion to Dismiss, ECF No. 15, is **DENIED**;
4. Defendants-Respondents are **PRELIMINARILY ENJOINED** and prohibited from arresting, detaining, or removing all noncitizen Plaintiffs-Petitioners and noncitizen members of the proposed class;
5. Defendants-Respondents **SHALL** release from custody all noncitizen Plaintiffs-Petitioners and noncitizen members of the proposed class, including release from orders of supervision and immigration detention;
6. This Order **SHALL** remain in full force and effect pending further proceedings; and

7. The parties **SHALL** resume the briefing schedule for Plaintiffs-Petitioners' Motion to Certify Class, ECF No. 9. Defendants-Respondents' response is due within fourteen (14) days of the date of this Order, and Plaintiffs-Petitioners' reply is due within fourteen (14) days of the date of Defendants-Respondents' response.
