BERN started protesting NSA's US military involvement (in particular the Military's potential use of space) in 1996. BERN members were arrested following an NSA protest on October 12, 2001, when BERN members and activists and activists and activists and Sister Ardeth Platte, O.P. attempted to deliver a letter to Lt. General Michael V. Hayden, head of the National Security Agency, demanding a meeting. NSA officials would not permit a meeting with Gen. Hayden and and Platte poured their own blood on the asphalt roadway to represent all victims of the NSA. They were charged with trespass, destruction of government
