On June 5, 2005, there was a demonstration/rally at Baker Park in Frederick, Maryland which began at 1:30 pm. After the rally, according to internet sources and the news articles, the group, the Frederick Progressive Action Coalition (FPAC) marched to Ft. Detrick to protest the plan to make Fort Detrick the site of a National Interagency Biodefense Campus (NIBC) and to protest the construction of the National Biodefense Analysis and Countermeasures Center (NBACC) and the manufacture of biological warfare agents in general by the U.S. Government.
