Executive Summary: The Taking Action for Animals conference will open with registration from 8am on Saturday July 16th. The conference banquet will take place on Saturday evening. Formal sessions will close at 6pm on Sunday July 17th. Activities on Monday July 18th will include a Lobby Day and an organized protest.



Intelligence Report: The Taking Action for Animals conference, sponsored by various animal rights groups is scheduled for July 16-18, 2005 at the Washington DC Renaissance Hotel. In conjunction with this conference, People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals (PETA) has planned this protest to ask the United States Department of Agriculture Headquarters (USDA), 1400 Independence Ave. SW Washington DC at 1145 hrs - 1300hrs to do their job and enforce the Animal Welfare Act with regard to the Covance animal testing lab in Vienna Virginia.
