

Maryland districts that have the lowest wealth are also the furthest from achieving "adequate" education funding.

Addressing Inequity in the Blueprint Education Funding Formula

- New formula requires local jurisdictions to pay their share of the "weights"
 - Compensatory Education (lowincome)
 - English Language Learners
 - Special Education
- Disequalizing & untenable for districts of low wealth due to large percentages of students in these categories
- Education Effort Adjustment provides additional state funding to districts of low wealth that show above average effort

Total = \$139.7 Million Unfunded
