PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

- 1. Plaintiffs, through their undersigned counsel, hereby move, pursuant to Rule 2-501(a), for summary judgment on the grounds that there is no genuine dispute regarding any material fact and that they are entitled to judgment as a matter of law.
- 2. For support of this motion, Plaintiffs rely on their Memorandum in Support of Petition for Judicial Review and in Support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment filed contemporaneously herewith.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs request that the Court:

- a) Grant this motion and enter judgment in their favor;
- b) Vacate the Defendants' Advance Determinations of non-referability of the Plaintiffs' petition of 2019 Md. Laws, ch. 25 to a vote of the electorate;
- c) Declare that Sections 2 and 3 of 2019 Md. Laws, ch. 25 are eligible for referral to the ballot pursuant to Md. Const. Art. XVI, § 1;

- d) Order, as the only adequate remedy, that the deadlines for Plaintiffs to submit petition signatures shall each be extended for nine days, to June 9, 2019, and July 9, 2019, respectively;
- e) Order that the Defendants shall complete all steps related to the certification process for Plaintffs' petition with all necessary speed and without reference to the Advance Determinations vacated hereby; and
- f) Grant such other and further relief as the Court deems appropriate to assure the integrity of the electoral process.
